Student Safety

▶ Adherence to COVID protocols:

- ▶ Mask wearing is going well
- ▶ While eating, students are sitting on blue tape to encourage social distancing
- ▶ Air filtration systems are always on
- ▶ Weekly COVID testing on site - Friday's

▶ Traffic Safety

- ▶ U-Turns in front of a school are illegal. Please go around the school.
- ▶ Do not have your children cross the street to meet you at dismissal.

▶ Fire Drill

- ▶ We did have a fire drill 8/25 - it went very well.

Positive COVID Case Procedure

- ▶ When notified of a positive COVID case, the person is immediately isolated if on campus and sent home.
- ▶ Close contacts are identified and contacted by the school to quarantine.
 - ▶ Close contact - within 6 feet for more than 15 minutes over a 24 hour period
- ▶ Case is reported to Community Engagement
 - ▶ At this point, community engagement manages communication and determines return dates and conditions.
 - ▶ Community Engagement communicates with the Principal.
- ▶ General letters are sent to staff and families notifying of a positive case.
- ▶ All locations where the positive individual was are immediately disinfected.

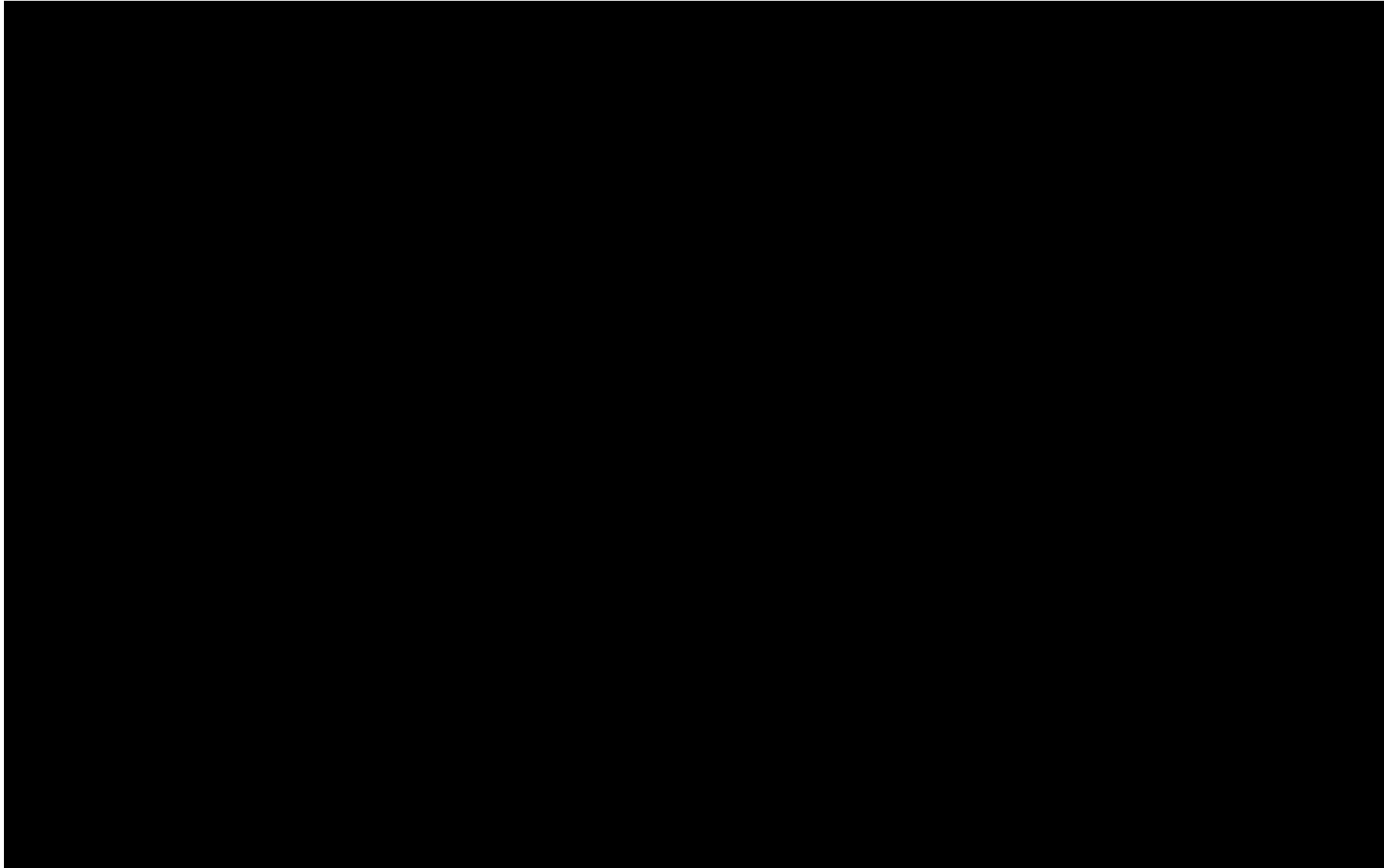

Reminders
